The Faculty of Natural Sciences at Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg, seeks to fill a tenured

W2-Professorship in Differential Psychology, Diagnostics and Evaluation (m/f/d)

at the Institute of Psychology starting in October 2025.

Otto von Guericke University (OVGU) in the state capital Magdeburg is a medium-sized university with a strong research agenda in neuroscience.

The faculty seeks a researcher with an outstanding track record in the area of differential psychology, as evidenced by the quality of publications and the acquisition of competitive third-party funding. The research focus of the newly appointed professor shall further strengthen the neuroscientific research focus of the institute of psychology. The professorship will also be an integral part of the broader dynamic neuroscientific community in Magdeburg comprising the institute of psychology, several departments of seven faculties (including Natural Sciences, Medicine, Economics, Informatics etc.), the Leibniz-Institute for Neurobiology (LIN), the German Centre for Neurodegenerative Diseases (DZNE); all collaborating under the umbrella of the Center for Behavioral Brain Sciences (www.cbbs.eu). The professorship is expected to contribute to the German Centre for Mental Health Magdeburg-Halle-Jena (www.c-i-r-c.de) and to the neuroscientifically oriented local research consortia (SFB1436 - Neural Resources of Cognition, Center for Behavioral Brain Sciences, GRK2413 -The Aging Synapse). Further collaboration with the institute's 2nd research focus Mensch-Technik-Interaktion is advantageous.

In addition, substantial expertise in using modern neuroscientific methods is required (e.g. eye-tracking, EEG, fMRI) for the characterisation of interindividual differences and the evaluation of interventions. The professorship will contribute to the clinical and scientific teaching programmes both in the polyvalent B.Sc. Psychology and the M.Sc Programmes of the Institute of Psychology.

Hiring requirements therefore include teaching experience in psychological diagnostics and interventions plus a Habilitation in psychology or comparable achievements (see § 35 (2, 3) HSG-LSA).

Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg is a signatory of the German Diversity Charter. We welcome your application, regardless of gender, cultural and social background, age or sexual orientation.
